

The newest CASLI Generalist Performance Exam is open and waiting for you! Do you have your test date on the calendar? Are you thinking about scheduling your test date? PERFECT! Rebekah has taken and passed the newest version of the CASLI Performance Exam and is excited to share with you all she learned about strategies she used for preparing for the exam, and tips for reducing your test anxiety.

This workshop will focus on the Performance portion of the NIC exam. During this workshop, participants will have an opportunity to walk through the format of the exams, participate in a mock exam, perform deliberate practice and self-analysis, ask questions, and compile a list of preparatory resources. Participants will leave this workshop with a better sense of how to prepare for this portion of the exam and know what to expect when entering the testing center. This session mentions, but does not focus on, the Generalist Knowledge Exam.

Participants will be able to:


- Identify the three parts of the new CASLI Generalist Exam process.
